

A total of 37 Questions were asked collectively through the Streaming Platforms YouTube, Facebook and Our Website






67% of the Attendees attend the full webinar from the start of the broadcast to the end which is a total of 112 attendee.





Post-Webinar Report

Counterfeit medicinal products are a threat to the health and safety of patients around the world.

Ramesh Raj Regional Director, Asia Pacific Pharmaceutical Security Insititute (PSI)



Counterfeiting groups thrive in countries where the anti-Counterfeiting laws are weak; the drug regulatory agencies are underfunded and understaffed; and legal sanctions are ineffective.

In assessing these illegal operations, it became clear that the counterfeiters often copied pharmaceutical products of many manufacturers and there was a need to improve information sharing.

Meeting the Challenge

In 2002, the Security Directors from fourteen major pharmaceutical companies established the Institute in Washington, D.C. Working with its members, PSI developed improved systems to identify the extent of the problem and to assist in coordinating international inquiries.

Today, PSI membership includes thirty-seven pharmaceutical manufacturers from many nations. The Institute established representational offices with staff in Miami, Florida; Singapore; and Stockholm, Sweden.

PSI currently works with both international and regional law enforcement agencies by sharing real time intelligence and initiating operations against criminal syndicates who are involved in counterfeiting and theft of medicines, and also illegal diversion of medicines.




